



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Features

• Rocker bottom to simulate natural gait

• Pneumatic Pump and Tall Design

 Large air bladder creates a larger surface for contact pressure to help control swelling and ensure a snug fit

To put on the ManaEZ Boot Air:

- 1. Open the boot liner without removing it from the boot.
- 2. Place the boot flat on the floor and put the foot inside the boot. Make sure the heel is all the way back to the back of the boot.
- 3. Secure the lining to the leg by overlapping the liner on the top of the foot and at the front of the lower leg.
- 4. Secure the Velcro straps beginning with the straps closest to the toes.

To Control the Air Pressure:

- 1. To put air inside the boot, turn the valve clockwise until secure, and then squeeze the bulb until you feel adequate pressure.
- 2. To remove air from the boot, simply turn the valve counterclockwise.
