


Step 1 Match the size using the chart to fit your waist match your belts size. Remove Velcro from belts and pull the tabs through to the sizing creases, securing the sizing flap with Velcro to your appropriate crease 1,2,3,4,5,6,7. For your appropriate size, see chart above and reference **Sizing** box to the left (in blue).



4XL & 4XL = 62" - 68" waist





L & L = 38" - 44" waist

XL & XL = 44" - 50" waist

Adjust the shoulder straps. And also adjust the front metal stay's length and angle. Readjust all straps and all stays until you feel comfortable.

Adjusting Posterior Support and Front Metal Stay Posterior Support



To adjust posterior support, first detach the mesh backing on the back of the brace, exposing the pulley compression system and Peel the Velcro strip securing the posterior support, and peel the Velcro strip securing the posterior support. While holding the back panel in one hand, use the other hand to gently pull the posterior support to the desired height. Re-attach the Velcro strip to secure the support in place and re-attach the mesh backing.

To adjust front metal support, first detach the two side panel of the front brace. Peel the oval foam bag and exposing all metal stay. And then use the wrench to loose screws. According to your height, adjust the length and angle. And then tighten up all screws. Finally put the metal stay back into foam bag.

Ice Pack: This can velcro into the brace

Application instructions
